### **City High School Adopts Jacome Plaza**

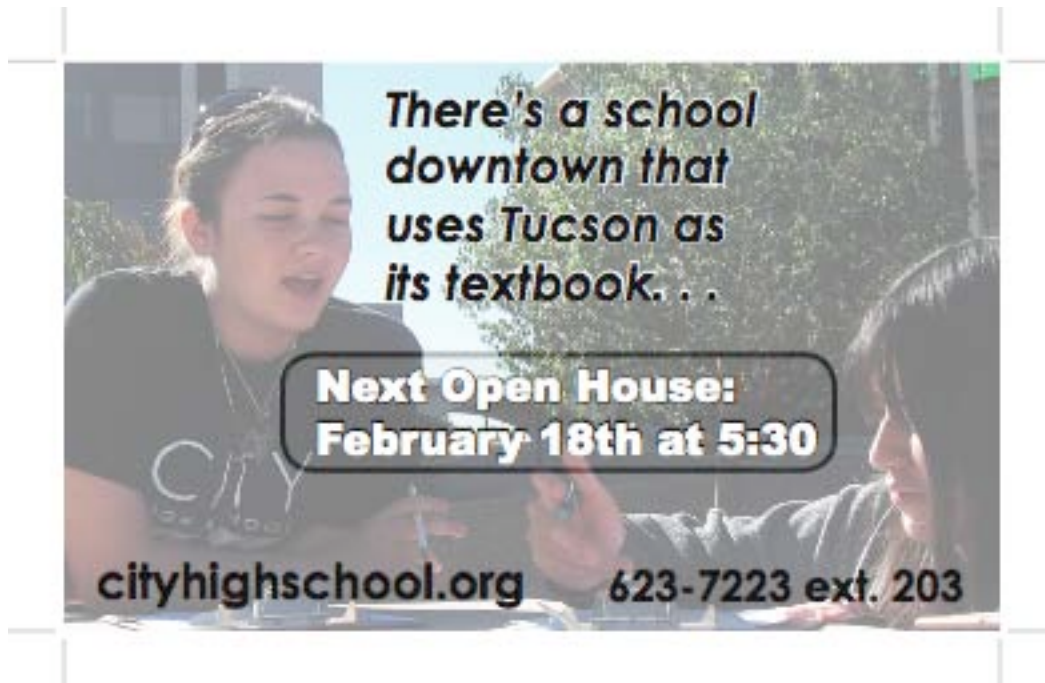
